By 2020, she found herself drawn to children's fiction, inspired by the wild, imaginative books that shaped her own childhood. She finished her first children's book that same year and soon after signed with Serendipity Literary Agency.

These days, Sharice calls Los Angeles home. She's busy weaving cinematic twists and page-turning suspense into mysteries for middle-grade readers, hoping to inspire courage, curiosity, and a love of storytelling in the next generation.
